COMMUNICABLE DISEASES ARE ON THE RISE

Most people who visited the SONSHIP clinic were little children less than 14 years of age. The main causes for these communicable diseases were because of unhygienic living or poor sanitation. Most children love swimming in the sea. Unconsciously these children were swimming in contaminated water polluted by the Tuna factory at Noro and a few logging companies that are currently operating in the Vonavona Lagoon. Most of the children came in with re-curent chest infections.

We educated them on passive smoking. These little children are passive smokers if parents continue to smoke at home without considering them. The chest infections will never be finished by drugs until the smokers go away somewhere to smoke.

We advised them to do regular clean up at home because dusts in the dirty houses can even cause the air-born, diseases like chest infections. Clothing needs to be washed regularly.


